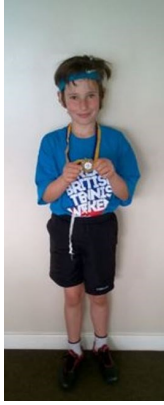
Both meetings will take place in New Hall with drinks at 7pm and a prompt start at 7.30pm. We anticipate the meetings will finish at approximately 8.30pm.
