Long grey trousers Long or short sleeved white shirt ( <b>button fastening, not Velcro</b> ) Long sleeved grey pullover – two stripes Maroon blazer Maroon anorak Cap (Years 1-3 only) Tie – striped, Years 1 – 3 with emblem, Years 4 - 6* Grey ankle-length socks Black shoes ( <b>not trainer style</b> )  Scarf (optional)* Maroon knitted hat and gloves (optional)	Knee length grey shorts (no side cargo pockets) Short sleeved white shirt ( <b>button fastening, not Velcro</b> ) Long sleeved grey pullover – two stripes Maroon blazer Maroon anorak Cap (Years 1-3 only) Tie – striped, Years 1 – 3 with emblem, Years 4-6* Grey ankle-length socks Black shoes ( <b>not trainer style</b> )  Maroon sun hat Lightweight raincoat (optional)

The maroon blazer and anorak do not need to be worn to school at the same time. As a general rule, the blazer is worn with Summer uniform and the anorak with Winter uniform. However, on cold or wet days during the Summer term, anoraks should be worn instead of a blazer.
