This positive view is coming through strong and clear in the Voice of Parent survey. Thank you to all who have already engaged and if you have yet to do so thank you in advance.

Next week we have The Romans visiting on Monday with Year 3, where history really does come off the page and to life in a fully interactive and immersive day. Matches begin in earnest and 2A will be entertaining and informing us in their class assembly on Friday. Friday also sees the first of the Woburn Charity event days with pupils invited for the princely sum of £1 to dress in green or as wild animals in support of wildlife charities in Australia. A great deal to look forward to!
