Hello Upper School,

A geometric shape or object is symmetric if it can be divided into two or more identical pieces that are arranged in an organized fashion. This means that an object is symmetric if there is a transformation that moves individual pieces of the object, but doesn't change the overall shape

Your challenge today is to create a picture or pattern with a vertical or horizontal line of symmetry.

Remember that your bricks need to be the same colour and size on either side of your symmetry line.

Have a go at creating a pattern or picture, with 1 line of symmetry or 2 lines of symmetry? How colourful can you make it?

Don't forget to share your work and results, so we can see how you're getting on.
